Scholarships with early deadlines

Stand for Children is now accepting applications for our next round of Beat the Odds Scholarships. **Beat the Odds is a \$16,000 award** (\$4,000 per year, renewable for up to four years) for students who are succeeding in school in the face of challenges such as poverty, homelessness, disability, systemic inequalities, etc.
